

ACTIVE TRAVEL COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. The Committee will act according to the General Terms of Reference for Committees and Working Groups.
- 2. To oversee the town wide 20mph scheme and actively look at opportunities to create a self-enforcing area.
- 3. To identify and prioritise opportunities to implement the Faversham Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP).
- 4. To work with neighbouring parishes, Swale Borough Council and Kent County Council to implement the Eastern Area Committee funded parish to town cycling and walking project.
- 5. Supporting the development of a cycling network linking with neighbouring towns.
- 6. To liaise with Highways Authority over maintenance aspects of the public highway network, both carriageway and footpath. To make recommendations for required works and performance through the Faversham Highways Improvement Plan.
- 7. To liaise with local public transport providers (including bus and train services) to identify opportunities for service improvements.
- 8. Continue to encourage cycling and walking through community engagement and events, such as Cycle Fest, Cycle to Work/School weeks.
- 9. Responsible for the outcome of the cycle hire trial, funded by the Eastern Area Committee.
- 10. Responsible for the outcome of the bike rack hire trial, funded by the Eastern Area Committee.
- 11. To investigate quiet streets or school streets initiatives.
- 12. To liaise with the Environment Committee to ensure that a coordinated approach is taken to the overall public realm.
