

**SWALE BOROUGH COUNCIL ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN  
POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (AS AMENDED)  
CIVIC REMEMBRANCE PARADE AND CHURCH SERVICE, FAVERSHAM**

WHEREAS during certain hours on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> November 2022 certain roads in Faversham will be thronged and liable to be obstructed Swale Borough Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 do hereby order and direct that the following regulations shall be observed: -

The streets named below shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the times set out opposite: -

Forbes Road – In its entirety	10:45am – 10:50am
Briton Road – From the junction of Forbes Road to the junction with Roman Road	10:45am – 10:50am
Roman Road – In its entirety	10:45am – 11:15am
Stone Street – From the junction with Roman Road to the junction with Preston Street	10:45am – 11:15am
Bank Street – In its entirety	11:15am – 11:25am
Preston Street – From the junction with Stone Street to the junction with East Street	11:15am – 11:25am
East Street – From the junction with Preston Street to the junction with Church Road	11:15am – 11:25am
Church Road – In its entirety	11:15am – 11:35am
<b>RETURN</b>	
Church Road – In its entirety	13:00pm – 13:15pm
East Street – From the junction with Church Road to the junction with Court Street	13:00pm – 13:15pm
Market Place – In its entirety	13:00pm – 13:25pm
Court Street – From the junction with Market Place to the junction with Crescent Road	13:00pm – 13:30pm

2. Drivers of vehicles will be diverted in accordance with direction found to be the most expedient.
3. The penalty for any infringement of the said regulation is a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
