| 6. | <p><u>Creek Bridge</u></p> <p>It was noted that there had been no response from the Department for Transport since the petition was deposited on 13th November.</p> <p>KCC had not proceeded with action, Haroona Chughtai intended to send a further letter to DfT, which AH had requested was shared with the Town Council.</p> <p>The next steps for the campaign were discussed</p> <p>It was proposed by Cllr J Rowlands seconded by Cllr P Cook and on being put to the meeting it was RESOLVED to recommend that the Mayor of Faversham writes to Peel Ports requesting that they fulfil their obligations and fix the sluices.</p> <p>It was proposed by Cllr T Martin seconded by Cllr J Rowlands and on being put to the meeting it was RESOLVED to recommend that the Town Council investigates the costs of a Judicial Review.
