020. Coach Parking

Cllr Cook had tried to contact Shepherd Neame and would contact again. Macknade would be happy to provide interim coach parking, at the previous annual rate. Other sites including Abbey School and Brogdale were also noted, but they would likely charge too.

Discussion took place around who we were marketing Faversham to and whether coach parties, from cruise ships or others, were the best target. With no current coach parking facilities it seemed better to focus on those travelling

by car or train. Open Faversham brought in visitors from the surrounding villages; work with fellow Cinque Port towns; explore a relationship with the National Maritime Museum. Tourism was about improving places and experience.
