1. Declarations of Interest

2. Update on Actions

A general discussion took place on the potential increase in fly-tipping. Capacity increase had been built into the new SBC contract, but the waste would be incinerated rather than recycled making the environmental argument stronger. The capacity for Sittingbourne HWRC had not been shared. The two days a week closure reduced capacity too much and would not work.

Deal and Swanley HWRCs had been added to the proposed closure list, but Faversham was still on all 4 options. Sheerness site had not been named, it was the smallest but seemed safe from closure. What is the rationale on the four options? Consultation was thought to start late July.

Potential for judicial review would be the reasonableness of the consultation; are the 4 options balanced and rational.

Concerns raised regarding battery and cartridge disposal.

The HWRC proposed closure will be on the agenda of Eastern Area Committee on 28th September.
