

SWALE BOROUGH COUNCIL ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (AS AMENDED) (FAVERSHAM CARNIVAL) AMENDMENT

WHEREAS during certain hours on Saturday 14th October 2023 various streets in Faversham will be thronged and liable to be obstructed the Swale Borough Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 do hereby order and direct that the following regulations shall be observed: -

1. The streets named below shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the times set out opposite their names: -

Whitstable Road - from junction with Millfield Road to junction of East Street	15:00 – 19:30

East Street – From junction with Whitstable Road to junction with Newton Road	18:00 – 21:00
Newton Road – From junction with East Street to Station Road	18:00 – 21:00
Station Road - From junction with Newton Road to junction with Preston Street	18:00 – 21:00
Preston Street – From junction with Station Road to junction with Market Street	18:00 – 21:00
Market Street - In its entirety	18:00 – 21:00
Market Place – In its entirety	18:00 – 21:00
Court Street - From junction with Market Place to junction with Abbey Street	18:00 – 21:00
Crescent Road – From the junction with Court Street to Abbey Street	18:00 – 21:00
Quay Lane – In its entirety	18:00 – 21:00
Conduit Street – In its entirety	18:00 – 21:00
Bridge Road – In its entirety	18:00 – 21:00
North Lane – From Conduit Street to South Road	18:00 – 21:00
South Road – North Lane to junction with Stone Street	18:00 – 21:00
Stone Street – From junction with South Road to junction with Preston Street	18:00 – 21:00
Dispersal	
Preston Street	18:00 – 21:30
Stone Street	18:00 – 21:30

2. Drivers of vehicles will be diverted in accordance with direction found to be the most expedient.
3. The penalty for any infringement of the said regulation is a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
