THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No.54) ORDER 2024 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL under sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (1) and (2), 32 (1), 35 (1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order:-

The effect of the proposed named Order will be to install waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL's means double yellow lines) waiting to be prohibited at any time.

Roads in Faversham in the Borough of Swale

EAST STREET – DYL – From its junction with Preston Street for a distance of 16 metres in an easterly direction. **MARKET STREET – DYL –** From its junction with Preston Street for a distance of 24 metres in a northwesterly direction. **PRESTON STREET – DYL –** (1) On the west side for its junction with Market Street to its junction with Stone Street. (2) On the east side from its junction with East Street for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction. (3) On the east side from a point 109 metres from the junction with East Street for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction across the access to Gatefield Road. (4) On the east side from a point in line with the northern kerbline of Stone Street for a distance of 34 metres in a northerly direction to join up with the existing lines. **SINGLE YELLOW LINES – SYL - Every day 6am to 6pm** (5) On the east side from a point 40 metres south of the junction with East Street for a distance of 69 metres in a southerly direction. (6) On the east side from a point 115 metres south of the junction with East Street for a distance of 43 metres in a southerly direction.

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby propose to make the following Order:-

A – This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment No.54" ('this Order') and shall come into force on the ** day of ****** 2024.

B - "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019" ('the Order of 2019') shall have effect as though-

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in Faversham in the Borough of Swale

The following to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:-

- EAST STREET (1) On both sides between its junctions with Crescent Road and Church Road.
 - (2) On the northern side

(a) between its junction with Church Road and the boundary between 20b/20 East Street;

(b) between the western boundary of 34 East Street and the boundary with Whitstable Road;

(c) between the junctions of Crescent Road and Market Street.

(3) On the southern side

(a) from the junction with Newton Road to a point 13 metres of a point opposite the eastern kerbline of Church Road;

(b) from a point 17 metres west of the centre of the junction with St Mary's Road to a point opposite the boundary between 20b/20 East Street;

(c) between points 15 metres west and 15 metres east of the centre of the junction with St John's Road;

(d) between points 15 metres west of the centre of the junction with Park Road and the boundary with Whitstable Road;

(e) between the junction of Crescent Road and a point in line with the eastern building line of 55 East Street;

(f) from its junction with Preston Street for a distance of 16 metres in an easterly direction.

The following to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:-

MARKET STREET (1) On the northern side from the junction with Market Place to the junction with East Street.

(2) On the southern side

(a) from a point in line with the eastern boundary of 13 Market Place to a point 1 metres west of the boundary of 12a/13 Market Street;

(b) from the junction with Preston Street for a distance of 24 metres in a westerly direction.

The following to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:-

PRESTON STREET (1) On the eastern side

(a) from the junction with East Street to a point in line with the boundary of 6/6a Preston Street;

(b) from a point in line with the northern boundary line of 19a Preston Street to a point in line with the boundary of 24/25 Preston Street;

(c) between points 17 metres and 29 metres south of the boundary of 24/25 Preston Street;

(d) between southern boundary of 37 Preston Street to a point 15 metres south of that point;

(e) from the junction with Station Road a point opposite the boundary of 55a/56 Preston Street;

(f) from the southern kerbline of Station Road for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction;

(g) from a point in line 1 metre north of the southern boundary of 14 Preston Street to a point 1 metre south of the northern boundary of the Alexander Centre, 15 Preston Street, across the entrance of Gatefield Lane.

(2) On the western side

(a) from the southern kerbline of Forbes Road south to the end of the Road;

(b) from a point in line with the southern boundary of 56 Preston Street to the northern kerbline of Forbes Lane;

(c) from a point 1 metre south of the northern building line of the Assembly Rooms to a point 1 metres north of the southern building line of 64 Preston Street;

(d) between a point in line with the southern boundary of 64 Preston Street to the junction with Market Street. a point 3 metres south of the southern boundary of 70 Preston Street;

(e) from a point opposite the boundary of Alexander Centre and 18 Preston Street to the junction with Market Street.
