No issues currently at Stonebridge allotments.

The site is running well, plot meets the standard of the tenancy agreement.

We are tidying up a tree that has fallen into the stream, work is still ongoing.

Davington Hill and Brent Hill, Hedges have been done, Informed KCC of work being done,

Logistics of removing foliage has been a problem, in the future this needs looking at.

Stonebridge lock-up has had some security put in place as the FTC chipper is being stored there.

Bridge work is to start in September, and we will have to close off the pond area.

Stonebridge has 66 people on the waiting list.

Millfield.

The water problem is still ongoing, Sandra Todd has taken this on as too many people were getting involved.

I have heard that Millfield now has funding for the new water pipe and meter

We have put in IBC tanks and have been filling tanks up around the site, hope this will be taken on by the committee till the new pipe is installed.

A space at Millfield Allotment has become available for FTC, this space will be used for Growing Plants for planters across the Town, there is an interest in Volunteers helping out, and we will have space to fix up benches and to store safely, this will be ideal for FTC Future projects, work is needed to get area up and running.

Millfield has 46 people on the waiting list and a few vacant plots which are being prepared for potential tenants.

St Nicholas.

No issues currently at St Nicholas allotment.

Have offered out plots to others who are waiting on other lists to take up vacant plots and have had no takers for this.

SBC have asked if they can put up a No Fly tipping sign-up around the site fencing.

Plots are vacant.

St, Nicholas has 0 on the waiting list.

Perry court.

No issues currently at Perry Court. There is still no movement on the site, waiting for a date.

Concerned about dog walks that use the area where there are no Dog bins in place and watering of trees, this would be good to get on top of this before it becomes a big problem when we do take over this space.

Perry Court has 44 people on the waiting list and continues to grow.

North Preston.
