

FTC ALLOTMENT REPORT.

Stonebridge.

No issues currently at Stonebridge allotments.

The site is running well, plot meets the standard of the tenancy agreement.

We are tidying up a tree that has fallen into the stream, work is still ongoing.

Done a patch-up on the bridge at Stonebridge Pond, when repairing we found that the bridge floor will need replacing ASAP.

R L Surveys carried out a Survey.

Stonebridge has 66 people on the waiting list.

Millfield.

We are working with Millfield Allotments on a water leak, Millfield allotment is looking to relocate the water pipe on the site, so the stopcock is more accessible, work is still ongoing.

We have put in two IBC tanks done work to the guttering for them to catch water in and have been filling tanks up around the site.

Millfield has 42 people on the waiting list and a few vacant plots which are being prepared for potential tenants.

St Nicholas.

No issues currently at St Nicholas allotment.

FTC will be helping St Nicholas with a rainwater system, having a site meeting to look over plans, and waiting for a reply from Jennie the Chairperson.

The Issue is with a new wooden fence put up by the builders which helps clime onto our fence when balls are kicked over, The CCTV sign is working.

St Nicholas has 4 people on the waiting list, no plots are vacant.

Perry court.

No issues currently at Perry Court. There is still no movement on the site, waiting for a date.

Perry Court has 44 people on the waiting list and continues to grow.

North Preston.

The new padlock is back from the locksmith and in place, after it had been vandalised, and reported to the police.

A new plot holder on plot 14B,

Plot 5B had been vandalised, no tools were stolen just veg pulled up.

We started work on vacant plots to get new plot holders on and to split bigger plots up and the site cleanup went well. My fingers are crossed it stays like that.

Pathways are cut and the plots trimmed down with a brush cutter, more to be done on-site.

The site started to move along fingers are crossed its moving in the right direction.

North Preston has 8 people on the waiting list and vacant plots.

Planter.

Planters around the Town, work has started, and new plants have been bought to fill out planters, we have a new volunteer for the Whitstable 20s planters.

Able Acres planter planted up, the last planter to do will be the post office.

The logistics of watering the planters and cubes (Daleks) is a mission with four containers and the water tank on wheels sometimes likes to work, but we are getting there slowly.
