Chestnut fencing has been ordered to mark out plots measuring 13m x 4.5m. In the first phase, 20 plots will be marked out.

Three padlocks have been ordered for the site; one key will fit all three padlocks, and 45 keys will be needed.

A tenant agreement has been sent out to people on the waiting list, for the first 20.
