Stonebridge.

There are no issues currently at Stonebridge allotments.

The site is running well, and the plot meets the standard of the tenancy agreement.

Bridge work started in September, and we will have to close off the pond area, floor to the bridge is done with treated wood and was treated again.

We are going to help Sally kerin with a bonfire in October, this is all the vegetation from Davington Hill and Brents Hill and wood from the bridge.

Stonebridge has 77 people on the waiting list.

Millfield.

The new water meter is going to be installed in October.

Millfield has 50 people on the waiting list and a few vacant plots which are being prepared for potential tenants.

St Nicholas.

There are no issues currently at St Nicholas allotment.

Have offered out plots to others who are waiting on other lists to take up vacant plots and have had no takers for this.

Plots are vacant.

St, Nicholas has 0 on the waiting list.

Perry court.

No issues currently at Perry Court. There is still no movement on the site, waiting for a date.

Concerned about dog walks that use the area where there are no Dog bins in place and watering of trees, it would be good to get on top of this before it becomes a big problem when we do take over this space.

Perry Court has 43 people on the waiting list and it continues to grow.

North Preston.

North Preston Allotment had its first AGM in October since 2019, it went well.

They would like the accounts to be in more detail for the next AGM, passed on to the treasurer.

A water key has been purchased for the site as the water meter is to be read monthly, as requested by the water company.

The toilet pipe that was taken down and is now back in place.

A push-along mower was sourced at no cost to FTC, for Angela Simmons to use.

The door to the North Preston allotment lock-up has come off, was not told about this nor told me who had done it, and this will need welding back on.

The site has started to move along. My fingers are crossed, and it's moving in the right direction.

North Preston has 5 people on the waiting list and one big plot vacant.
