

# FTC ALLOTMENT REPORT.

## Stonebridge.

There are no issues currently at Stonebridge allotments.

## Millfield.

There are no issues currently at St Nicholas allotment.

There are vacant plots on the site.

## Perry court.

No issues on site, working well.

Knee rail fencing has been delivered and is ready to be installed.

The walking trails need cutting. The prices for a sit-on mower to hire, from Go Mowers £150 a day.

The container work still needs to be done inside, make a shadow board for the plot holder, hand tools. Price £60 - £70

The landscape that's on site needs to be signed off on our area, but my concern is that there are trees that are dead and need replacing, and stone or flint needs to be removed. To get hold of the person overseeing this is difficult to pin down. when trying to get a meeting, they turn up on a different day and then phone to say the work is done. keep asking for a tree plan of the site, no luck. An email has been sent to the project manager.

Mowing the side of the paths and trail pathways will start when I have found a hire company and have the go ahead.
