

Dropped Kerbs and Crossings

On 4th February, RG had a conversation with Lavinia Loft of Faversham Umbrella regarding her experiences with navigating the pavements and roads in Faversham.

Issues she identified:

A2 London Road – lack of dropped kerbs on one side of the road including the area by builder's yard also no crossing near the Abbey School on A2 London Road for wheelchair users.

Court St – issues with the cobbled areas, parking on cobbled areas blocking movement.

Lack of formal crossing near Stonebridge/Westbrook and traffic not adhering to 20mph limit causing issues trying to cross.

North Lane behind the brewery vans blocking dropped kerbs – no pavement on one side and no dropped kerbs to get to North Preston Estate.

South Road/Stone Street – issues in wet weather with deep puddles.

Love Lane – lack of crossing near Love Lane Estate.

In a conversation with Fiona Palmer, FTC Charters Officer, the following areas were of concern:

A2 Canterbury Road near Macknade – a pedestrian crossing would be helpful.

Athelstan/Ethelbert/Kingsnorth – a shortage of drop kerbs.

General state of pavements in Whitstable Road and near The Market Inn where the camber of the pavement is uneven.
