**ELIGIBILITY:** To apply for an allotment plot you must be a permanent resident of Faversham, living within one of the Town Council's Wards and aged over 18 years of age (proof of residence will be required for all new tenancies) and submit a completed Application Form.

We will put you on the waiting list for a site of your choice and contact you when you are at the top of the list and a plot becomes available. We may also occasionally offer plots when they become available on other nearby sites, however you can still choose to wait for a site of your choice.

Please make sure that you notify us of any change of address or other contact details so that we can contact you when a plot becomes available.

**WAITING LIST POSITION & WAITING TIMES:** Unfortunately we are not able to inform applicants of how long they can expect to remain on the waiting list before they are offered a plot. Allotment plots usually become available either when a tenant gives up a plot, or if a tenancy has been terminated due to a breach of the tenancy agreement. As a result, it is not possible to predict how many plots may become vacant during any given period.

We ask you to be patient whilst waiting for a plot to become available. Once you reach the top of the waiting list and a plot becomes available, you will be contacted by a representative of the Town Council.

**INFORMATION TO NOTE:** It is the responsibility of the applicant to keep Faversham Town Council informed of up to date contact details.

Waiting list applicants who cannot be contacted due to incorrect contact details, will be removed from the waiting list.

If an applicant does not respond to an invitation to view a plot within 14 days, then their details will be removed from the waiting list.

The Town Council reserves the right not to grant an Allotment Plot where there is evidence of previous plot misuse, or a history of enforcement action for such matters as non-payment of rent, or cultivation issues.
