# 450. Ham Farm Application for Statutory Review Under S.288 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (Stage 1)

Cllr Rowlands set out the grounds for the application for a Statutory Review.

Standing Orders were suspended to allow members of the public to speak.

Member of the Public 1 – The member of the public commented that it was important to support the action, not just for the Neighbourhood Plan, but for the Nation as a whole.

Member of the Public 2 – The member of the public queried whether the action could be posted on social media. Cllr Rowlands responded that yes it could and to check the Town Council website and social media for guidance.

Member of the Public 3 – The member of the public queried whether fundraising was still required. The Town Clerk responded that more would be known on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2025 when the respondents' replies were required to be submitted. At that point the Council would need to meet and decide what the next stage is. If a Statutory Review was to proceed there would be a potential need for further fundraising.
