02/09/2025: AGGRAVATED VEHICLE TAKING

Report of a theft of vehicle. Police have located the stolen vehicle, and the vehicle has intentionally driven into the police car. The suspect decamped and was not located. Investigation ongoing.

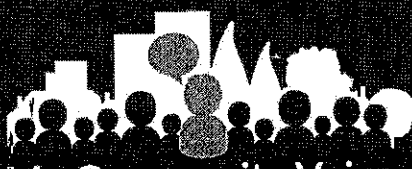
