Active Travel Committee, 3rd July 2025

Existing Bike Hangars and Planning for Future Provision

1. Overview

Faversham currently hosts three bike hangars, each accommodating six bikes, which have proven successful and are at or near full capacity. Residents have expressed positive feedback on their convenience and security.

The growing demand for secure bike storage highlights the need to expand this provision. Feedback from residents and local data suggests multiple potential sites for a fourth bike hangar, detailed in Section 5 below.

2. Review of Current Charging Structure

Faversham Town Council currently charges £30 per half year for a space in a bike hangar — equivalent to £5 per month. A review of other local authority charges provides helpful context:

Faversham's fee is among the lowest in the country, which ensures affordability, but does mean operating costs are mostly subsidised.

3. Supporting Residents on Low Incomes

The Council has expressed interest in offering reduced or free bike hangar access to residents on low incomes. However, verifying income levels presents challenges regarding data protection (GDPR) and administration.

Options for consideration:

- Referral-based system: Accept referrals from trusted community partners (eg Citizens Advice, social housing providers).
- **Universal Credit or benefits status**: Allow voluntary submission of proof, though this may deter uptake due to stigma or privacy concerns.

However, those interested in hiring a space have not expressed difficultly in paying the fee, or that it is too expensive.

4. Funding Opportunities

The upcoming round of Community Infrastructure Grants will include bike storage solutions.

The Town Clerk will be preparing a submission outlining the case for a fourth (and potentially fifth) bike hangar, using current usage data and public demand evidence.

5. Suggested Locations for a Fourth Bike Hangar

Based on 15 public responses (see appendix), the following locations are recommended for consideration for new bike hangars:

- · Vicinity of Faversham Station
- Vicinity of Westgate Road
- Vicinity of Fielding Street

6. Recommendations

- 1. Explore grant opportunities as soon as Community Infrastructure Grants open.
- 2. Review pricing structure annually to balance affordability with sustainability.
- 3. Seek permission for one or more of the above locations for installation of a fourth hangar.
