

ACTIVE TRAVEL COMMITTEE

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. The Committee will act according to the General Terms of Reference for Committees and Working Groups.
- 2. The Committee's prime aim is to promote sustainable transport and active travel including cycling and walking.
- 3. To oversee the town wide 20mph scheme and actively look at opportunities to create a self-enforcing area.
- 4. To identify and prioritise opportunities to implement the Faversham Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP).
- To work with neighbouring parishes, Swale Borough Council and Kent County Council to promote the Eastern Area Committee funded parish to town cycling and walking project.
- 6. Supporting the development of a cycling network linking with neighbouring towns. To liaise with Highways Authority over maintenance aspects of the public highway network, both carriageway and footpath. To make recommendations for required works and performance through the Faversham Highways Improvement Plan.
- 7. To liaise with local public transport providers (including bus and train services) to identify opportunities for service improvements.
- 8. To oversee and support the continuation of the Faversham Hopper Community Bus Service.
- Continue to encourage cycling and walking through community engagement and events, such as Active Travel Month, Cycle to Work/School weeks.
- 10. To investigate quiet streets or school streets initiatives as opportunities arise.
- 11. To liaise with the Environment Committee to ensure that a coordinated approach is taken to the overall public realm.
