**497. Apologies for Absence**

**499. Queen Matilda Place**

Cllr Crayford proposed an amendment to the motion to add lessons learned from the situation.

Cllr T Martin proposed an amendment to the motion to add the Planning Committee to create a street naming policy.

Cllr Crayford proposed a further amendment to refer to the Planning Committee for recommendations.

It was noted that a street naming policy exists but does not take account of existing footpaths and will be amended accordingly.

All amendments failed to get a seconder and fell.

It was proposed by Cllr Cook, seconded by Cllr Eyre and on being put to the meeting it was ***RESOLVED to withdraw the request for the footpath to be name Queen Matilda Place and respectfully ask that Swale Borough Council withdraw the naming proposal and from any current or pending legal proceedings related to this matter.***

## ANNEX - A brief precis of public session

Ann Furedi urged for the matter to be put to bed and respectfully request that Swale Borough Council does not attend court. She noted of the 1000 signatories, just under 400 were Faversham residents.

Maria Newman raised concerns for the use of public money.

Brian Planner asked why the properties on the footpath were not originally consulted, as it could have resolved the issue from the start.
