2. Declarations of Pecuniary and Non-Pecuniary Interests
Members who have an interest to declare on any items on the Agenda, must declare the existence and nature of it at the start of the meeting and act in accordance with the Council's Code of Conduct (s27 Localism Act 2011).
3. Notification of the Judge's decision on the application for permission to apply for Planning Statutory Review for Ham Marshes
Following consideration of the documents lodged by the Town Council (Claimant) and the Acknowledgments of Service filed by the First and Third Defendants; Order by the Honourable Mrs Justice Lang DBE confirms permission to apply for a planning statutory review is granted.

The Town Council to consider the following matters:

- a) To receive a verbal update on the Save Ham Marshes Appeal.
- b) To note this is an Aarhus Convention claim within the meaning of CPR 46.24. The standard costs limits in CPR 46.26 apply. The Claimant's liability for the costs incurred by the Defendants is limited to £10,000 in total. Each Defendant's liability for the costs incurred by the Claimant is limited to £35,000. The Third Defendant's (Gladman) application to vary the Claimant's costs limit is refused.
- c) The Town Council to consider and agree whether to proceed to the next stage of the Planning Statutory Review.
