

Agenda Item 7 – Project Plan for Mobility and Safety Project

Project Budget: £5000

Project Aim:

To improve the environment of local alleyways, and footpaths to help residents feel more confident to use them after dark and to aid more journeys on foot.

Potential Activities:

- 1) Run a residents survey to establish which routes residents are most concerned about using, particularly at night.
- 2) Commission professional advice about best solutions to problems identified so that appropriate organisations (KCC, Swale Community Partnership, Housing Associations and other landowners) can be lobbied as effectively as possible for solutions.

- Upper St Anns Road – Requested by a member of the public. Exact location unclear but described as at the top – so possibly on junction with A2.
- Preston St – alleyway beside Moonlight Café that leads to Newton Place Surgery
