227. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

229. MAGNA CARTA

Members received Paper 1 - Charter Officers Report.

It was noted that the Charter Officer does not have capacity for more school visits presently, the possibility of recruiting volunteers for school visits could be considered in the future.

HG reminded members that the Town Council has additional charters which are not on display. Members agreed that changing the exhibition should be considered in 2027.

231. TOWN QUAY VISITOR MOORINGS

Members received Paper 3 – Visitor Mooring Comparisons

It was noted that there are no facilities at Town Quay which should be reflected in the mooring price. Members noted that prior to the asset transfer, Swale Borough Council had been charging £8 per night.

It was proposed by Cllr C Gibson, seconded by Cllr T Martin and on being put to the meeting it was **RESOLVED that the charge for a visitor mooring at Town Quay should be £10 per night.**

232. THE OLD TOWN WAREHOUSE

The RIBA Stage 1 report was tabled at the meeting.

The Deputy Town Clerk reported that the first community engagement event in the Old Town Warehouse took place on Friday 23rd July, which 65 members of the public attended. The building will be open on Sunday 2nd April and Saturday 12th September.

233. THE GUILDHALL

The Chair gave a verbal report on the meeting that had been heard earlier in the day with the Project Administrator.

It was proposed by Cllr J Rowlands, seconded by Cllr T Martin and on being put to the meeting it was **RESOLVED that the following recommendations should be made to Town Council:**

- 1) That the Contract between the appointed Guildhall Contractor and the Town Council should be signed**
- 2) That the first invoice from the contractor should be paid.**
- 3) That the Mayor should write directly to the Contractor requesting that they speed up communications between the Project Administrator and themselves.**
